

Accumulated real GDP growth (Base index 2005=100)



The only free ports in the Atlantic coast of South America




- Goods exempted from domestic taxes and imports charges.






Protected youth work Young people up to 29 years of age, households below the poverty line Subsidy: up to 80% of the monthly salary.




